
Roy L. Chapman 81, of Zellwood, passed away on October 29, 2013. He was born in Clinton, Tennessee and moved to this area in 1989 from Irving, Texas. He was retired from the United States Army and had served in the Korean War and the Vietnam War; he was a recipient of the Bronze Star. Roy also worked a number of years for Braniff Airlines. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Mount Dora. Roy is survived by his wife Sue; they were married for 52 years. 


