Hector Garcia 97, of Sorrento, passed away on July 25, 2014. He was born in Mexico City, Mexico and moved here in 1995 from Long Island, New York. He founded Amerford International Corporation in 1946 and was a leader in the international freight forwarding business, but more importantly, he was a true gentleman. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 9 AM on Tuesday, July 29th in St. Patrick Catholic Church, Mount Dora.

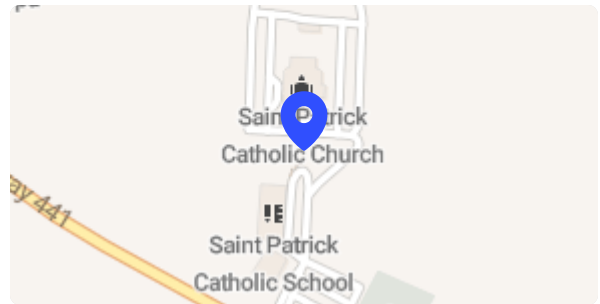
