# **Audrey H. Corriston**

**A**udrey Reid Corriston, 87, beloved wife, mother and grandmother, passed peacefully with family at her side on August 3rd after a long illness and a life well-lived. She was a beautiful person, accomplished and loving; an optimist with a sparkle in her eye, and a smile and kind word for everyone she met. Audrey truly enjoyed every minute of her life and to know her was to love her. She will be missed so much.

Audrey grew up in Kearny, NJ. After high school, she worked for several years as an office supervisor, leaving to be a dedicated wife and mother when she married her handsome high school sweetheart, the late Edward Corriston, Jr. after his return from the Navy in WWII. They raised three children in Bloomfield and Morris Plains, NJ. In 1968 the family moved to Germany and France to work and travel for several years before returning to Pompano Beach, FL. where she was active in her church organization and cared for her wonderful parents, the late Jack and Hazel Ross Reid. 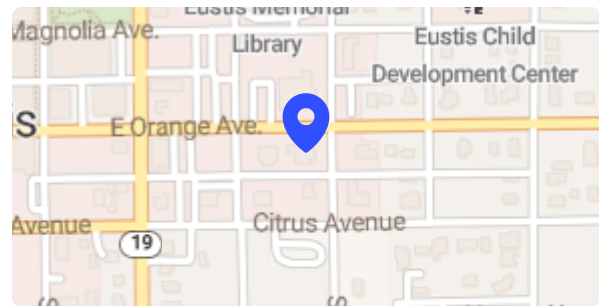

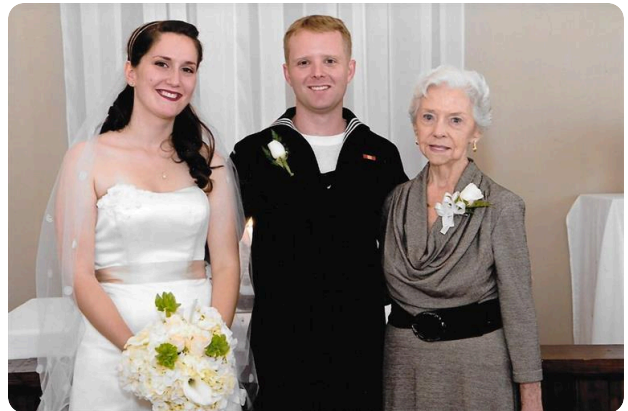
