George L. Sceblo 78, of Mount Dora, went to be with the Lord on September 7, 2014. He was born in New York City and moved here in 1995 from Boynton Beach. George was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church of Mount Dora, a graduate of Pace Institute College of New York City, he had worked as a Traffic Manager for Ross Engineering of New Brunswick, New Jersey, an International Traffic Manager for Revlon Corporation and was the retired Supervisor of the Palm Beach County Water Utility Department. He is survived by his wife Frances; they were married for 54 years. Also surviving are his daughter and son-in-law Alexandra and Michael Truitt of Eustis, sister; Leonora “Lee” Sceblo of The Villages and his Roseville, California siblings; Christopher DeSeblo, Margo DeSeblo and Christine DeSeblo. 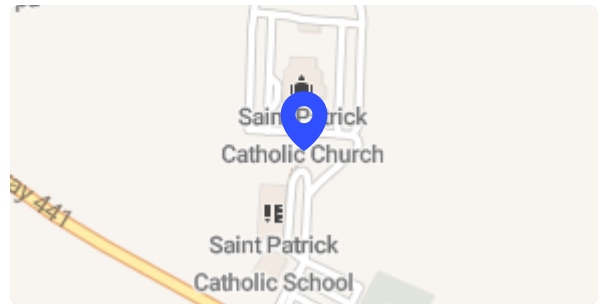

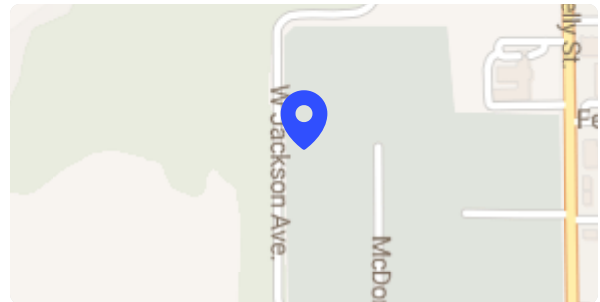
