Art was a Christian and the retired Fleet Maintenance Director for Golden Gem Growers of Umatilla, he was a veteran of the United States Navy having served in World War II and was a Pearl Harbor survivor. 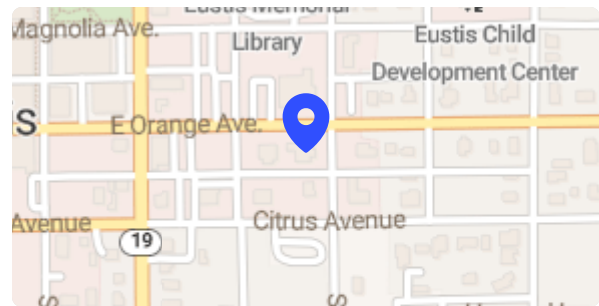

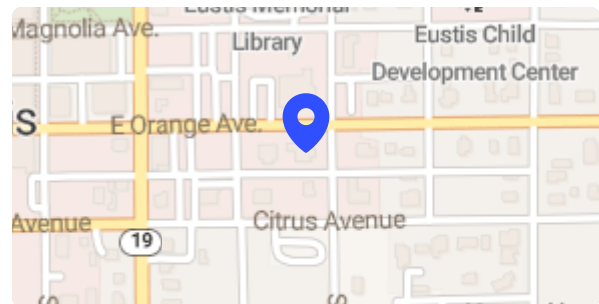

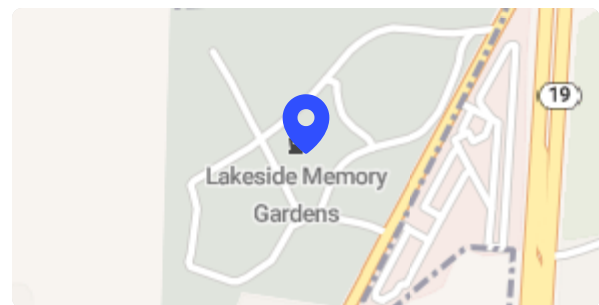
