The family will greet friends from Noon until the service hour.



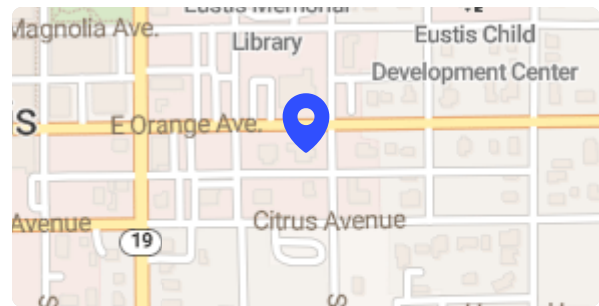

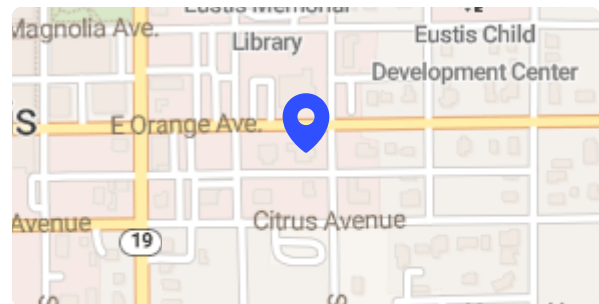
