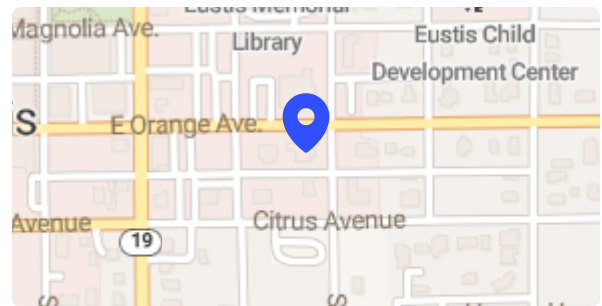

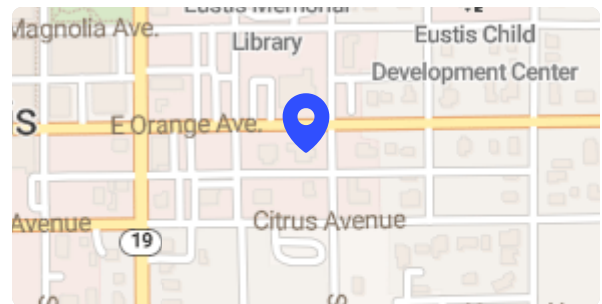

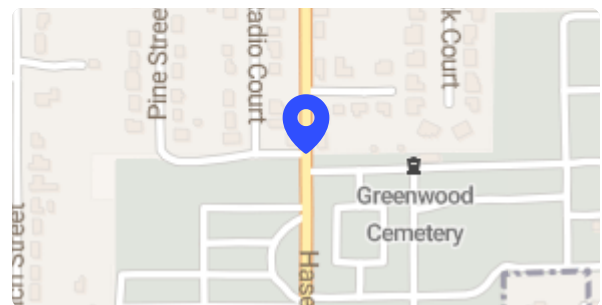

His laugh was unforgettable (contagious). I also treasure the Bronson family history that he had researched and shared with us over the years. We are fortunate that he cared enough to invest his time and energy to show his love in that way to his extended family. One specific happy memory was the summer vacations our families took together in the 60's to the Power's family mountain cabin by the creek (Happy Valley), with his cocker spaniels swimming in the ice-cold pool, watching my Dad Jimmy playing 'competitive' strategy board games (like Masterpiece, Clue, Monopoly) 'gambling' card games with Uncle Bubba at night for hours to pass the time because there was no TV. Also I do recall another pretty cool camping vacation that I believe Uncle Bubba helped organize for the Bronson clan - an epic Road Trip that only the fearless Bronson men took in the 70's to the wild West mountains. That was a big adventure for sure, based on the photo evidence that survived...that trip was hard to top. I regret we had lost touch somewhat over the last 15-20 years as we all got older and scattered, but he was loved, and along with my Mom Rosemary, brother Jim, Jr., and sister Susanne, I honor his life & memory on this day that he was laid to rest in Eustis FL.
