He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church of Mount Dora and a Veteran having served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. He was an Operations Manager for the Bank of New York Mellon / Pershing on Wall Street and later in Lake Mary, Florida. He was a member of the amputee support group at Florida Hospital Waterman. 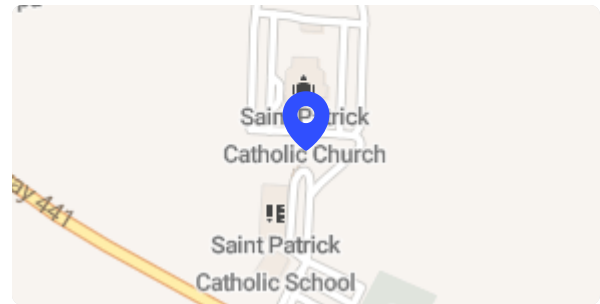
