Scared her more than it did me I think. I spent a lot of time at their house in high school too. My favorite memory of my Aunt Jean is when I was going to the Eustis prom and she came and picked me up in Orlando because I was in a cast up to my shoulder and couldn't drive. She was right by my side the whole time I got ready and even curled my hair for me. She spoiled me so... I can picture her now standing behind me, both of us looking into the mirror, as she was curling my hair and we were both laughing so hard because us two together was a hoot!
