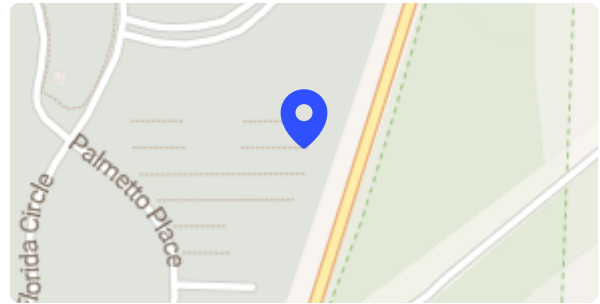

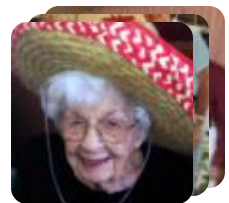
Bob Rush posted:
