Clifford Gerald St. Louis, born November 10, 1936 in Umatilla, Florida passed away of September 17, 2019 at the age of 82. He established his own business, St. Louis Heating And Air Conditioning in the 1960's. After 50 years of running his very successful Lake County business he retired. He generously helped many people unselfishly and without expecting recognition. After retirement he was able to enjoy his place at the beach and his hobbies, tennis, fishing and traveling. Clifford was one of the original members of St. Mary of the Lakes Catholic Church of Eustis. 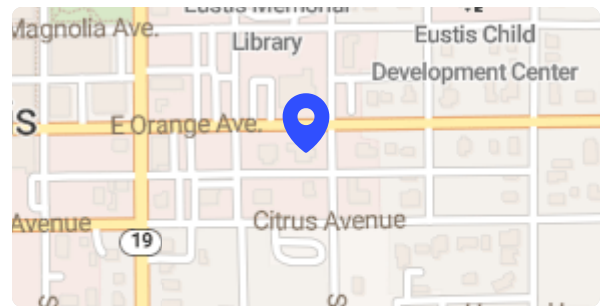

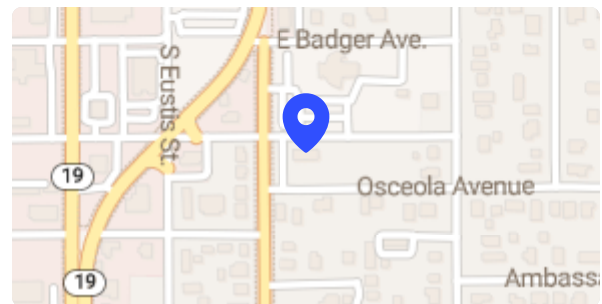

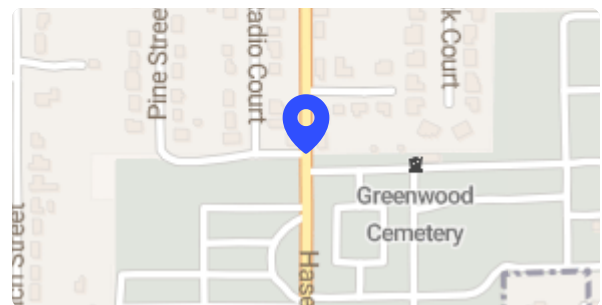
