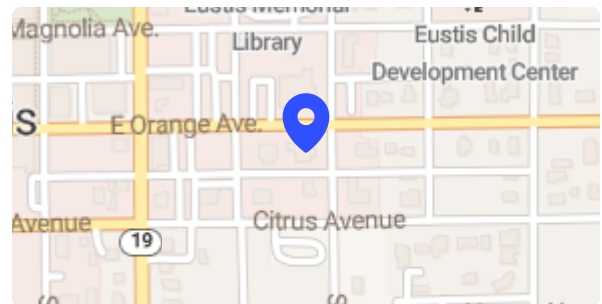

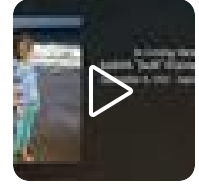

I realized her deep love for her children. I am unable to download it so I will print it. It is such a beautiful tribute to Judi, and it should be heard or read, by her family and friends. Mom's Heart Long ago and far away, I was born on the 15th of May. A sister of two, no dad to help out, she still took me home: she'd keep me no doubt. From infant to toddler, to took care of me, her beautiful baby she only did see. From four until nine she guided me through, she fed me and clothed me: she was there while I grew. 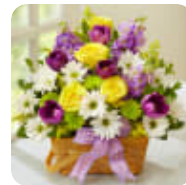
