Charles L. "Charley" Broadway, 81, of Eustis passed away on Wednesday June 3, 2009. He was born in Meigs, Georgia and had lived in Eustis all his life. Mr. Broadway was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Eustis and a Veteran having served in the U.S. Navy during WWII. Mr. Broadway was a former educator and administrator for Lake County Public Schools, having taught and coached at Eustis High School. He was Past President of the Eustis Kiwanis Club, and the Lake County Education Association, and was also a member of the V.F.W. He is survived by his wife Virginia "Ginny" Broadway; his sons Chuck (Brenna) Broadway of Eustis and James M. (Sherry) Broadway of Roswell, Georgia; his grandchildren Amanda Parsel, Jake Broadway, Matt Broadway, Casey Broadway, Jim Broadway Jr., Steven Broadway and Sam Broadway and his brother Harold of Grand Island.
