She attended St. Mary of the Lakes Catholic Church of Eustis. Our mother went to meet her husband, Felix; brothers, John and Chuckie, also sisters, Helen, Stella and Ann; and grandson, Rick Sinkovic, all of whom passed away years ago. For the past 7 years Mother has been in Eustis, Florida, staying with her daughter Joy, and this is where she passed away, going to meet with her loving family.
