Hubert "Jack" Rayburn, 74, of Tavares, FL passed away in Deland on Tuesday, February 1, 2011. He was born in Poulan, GA and moved to Tavares as a child in 1946. He owned and operated a lawn service company and prior to that had been a title examiner for several companies in Lake County. Jack was a veteran of the United States Army, a former Tavares Rotarian, and a volunteer fireman. He was of the Baptist faith and dedicated 41 years to helping others through Alcoholics Anonymous. Jack is survived by Linda, his wife of 49 years; his brother, Leonard, Shalimar, FL; numerous sisters-in-law; many nieces, nephews, great nieces and great nephews. He was preceded in death by six brothers and sisters. A memorial service was held in the Hamlin & Hilbish Chapel, 326 E. Orange, Eustis, FL, on Saturday, February 5, 2011 at 3 O'clock PM.
