## **George S. Pearson**

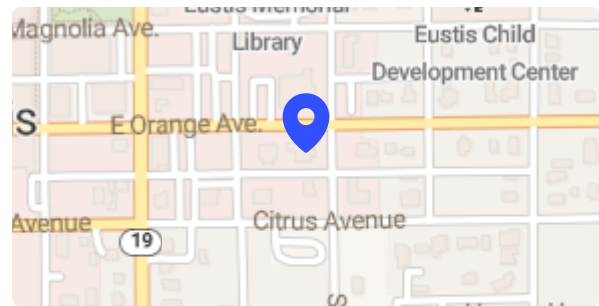

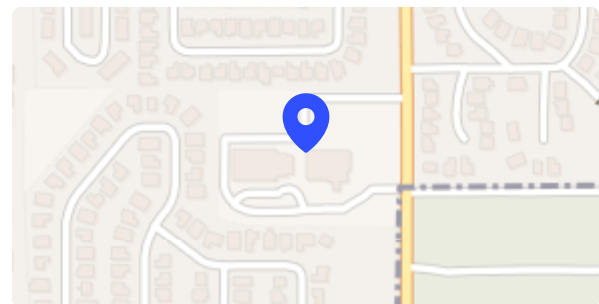
