Mr. Luis E. Morales of Mount Dora, Florida passed away on Friday, November 23, 2012 at the age of 71 years. He was born in Aguada, Puerto Rico to Luis and Perfecta Morales. Luis served his country in the US Air Force during Vietnam. He retired from the Federal Aviation Administration after a long career of more than 30 years. He and his wife, Judy, moved to this area in 2006 from Kansas City, Missouri. He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Mount Dora. Luis loved gardening and tinkering in the garage. He could fix anything. He was a gentle man and a friend and neighbor to all. He was always willing to help out or loan a tool. 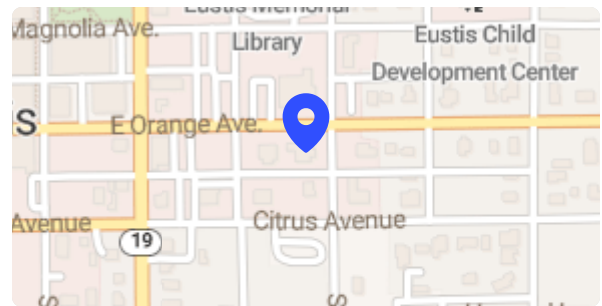

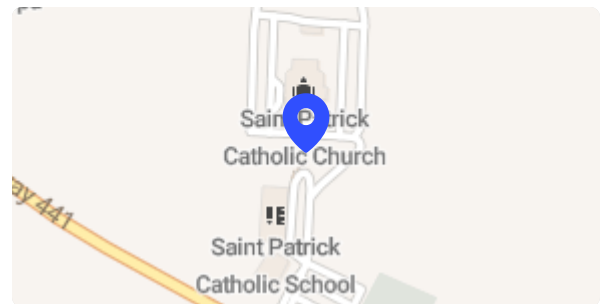


Mass of the Resurrection

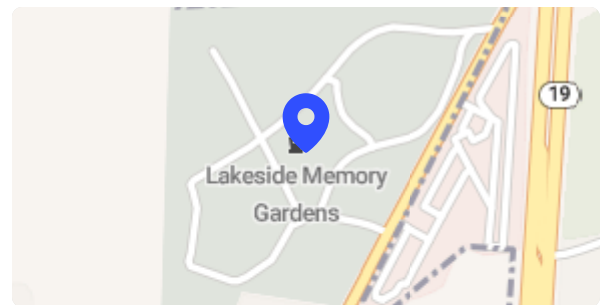
