Condolences, memories, and photos may be shared on the tribute wall.



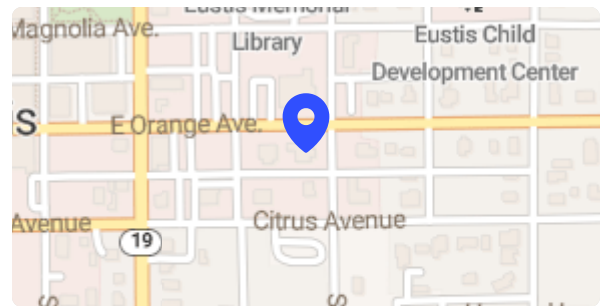
