## James Robert Ridout September 13, 1940 – November 8, 2025

James Robert Ridout, age 85, of Eustis, Florida, passed away peacefully on November 8, 2025. Born in Portsmouth, Ohio, on September 13, 1940, James lived a life marked by dedication, craftsmanship, and quiet strength.

James proudly served in the United States Army for four years, stationed in Hawaii, before embarking on a long career in telephone utility and technical work. In the 1970s, he relocated to Florida, where he spent the remainder of his life.
